



Week 2: Using Our Talents to Serve Others

Dear Families,

This week in **TFA Kids**, your child learned that God gives each of us special talents and abilities—not just for ourselves, but so we can **serve others and honor God**. We talked about how everyone is created differently on purpose, and how God can use kids *right now* to make a difference.

Just like athletes train and use their skills to help their team, God invites us to use the talents He's given us to help others and point people to Him.

FAITH FACT for this week:

I will use the talent God has given me to serve others.

Say this Faith Fact with your child throughout the week and help them notice the things they enjoy and are good at. Encourage them to think about how those talents can be used to help others—at home, school, church, or with friends.

BIBLE STORY: Daniel 2:25–49

Talk about how King Nebuchadnezzar had a dream that no one could understand. God gave Daniel the ability to interpret the dream, and Daniel chose to use his gift to help the king and give glory to God.

Daniel didn't rely on his own power—he trusted God. Because Daniel used his talent faithfully, God used him to help others and gave him even more responsibility.

Just like Daniel, we can use what God has given us to serve others and show them who God is.

MEMORY VERSE

“He rescues and he saves; he performs signs and wonders in the heavens and on the earth. He has rescued Daniel from the power of the lions.” **Daniel 6:27 (NIV)**

Tip: Practice the verse once a day—try saying it with hand motions, while driving, or before bedtime.



FAMILY DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Use these questions during a meal or bedtime:

- What special talent did God give Daniel in the story?
- Why do you think Daniel chose to use his talent to help the king?
- What are some things you enjoy doing or feel good at?
- How can we use our talents to help others this week?

FAMILY ACTIVITY

Choose one or more activities to do together this week:

- Have each family member share one thing they enjoy or feel good at
- Help someone at home using a talent (organizing, helping younger siblings, cooking, encouraging others)
- Write or draw a picture for someone who needs encouragement
- Pray together and thank God for the gifts He has given each family member

After each activity, say together:

“I will use the talent God has given me to serve others!”

PRAYER TO PRAY TOGETHER

“God, thank You for giving each of us special talents. Help our family use what You’ve given us to help others and bring You glory. Show us ways we can serve this week. Amen.”
